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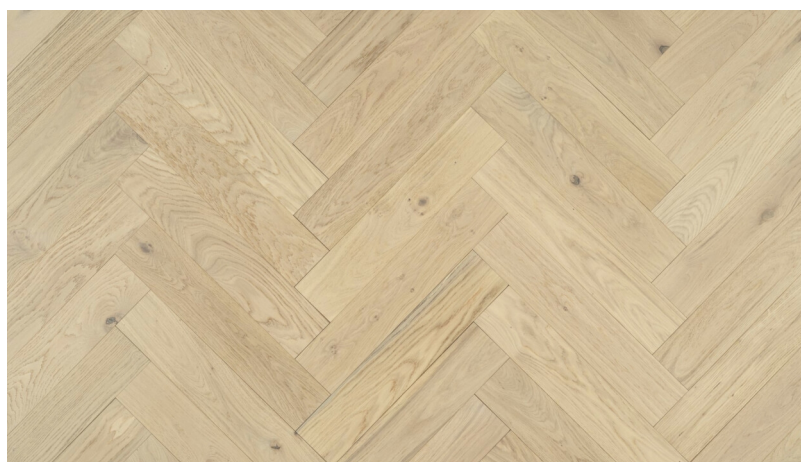

Texture	Slightly Brushed

Grading description – 2 criteria

Knots

Scale from (rigid) parquet without knots up to planks with more and larger knots



Colour variation

From little colour variation/sapwood to bigger colour variation/sapwood
